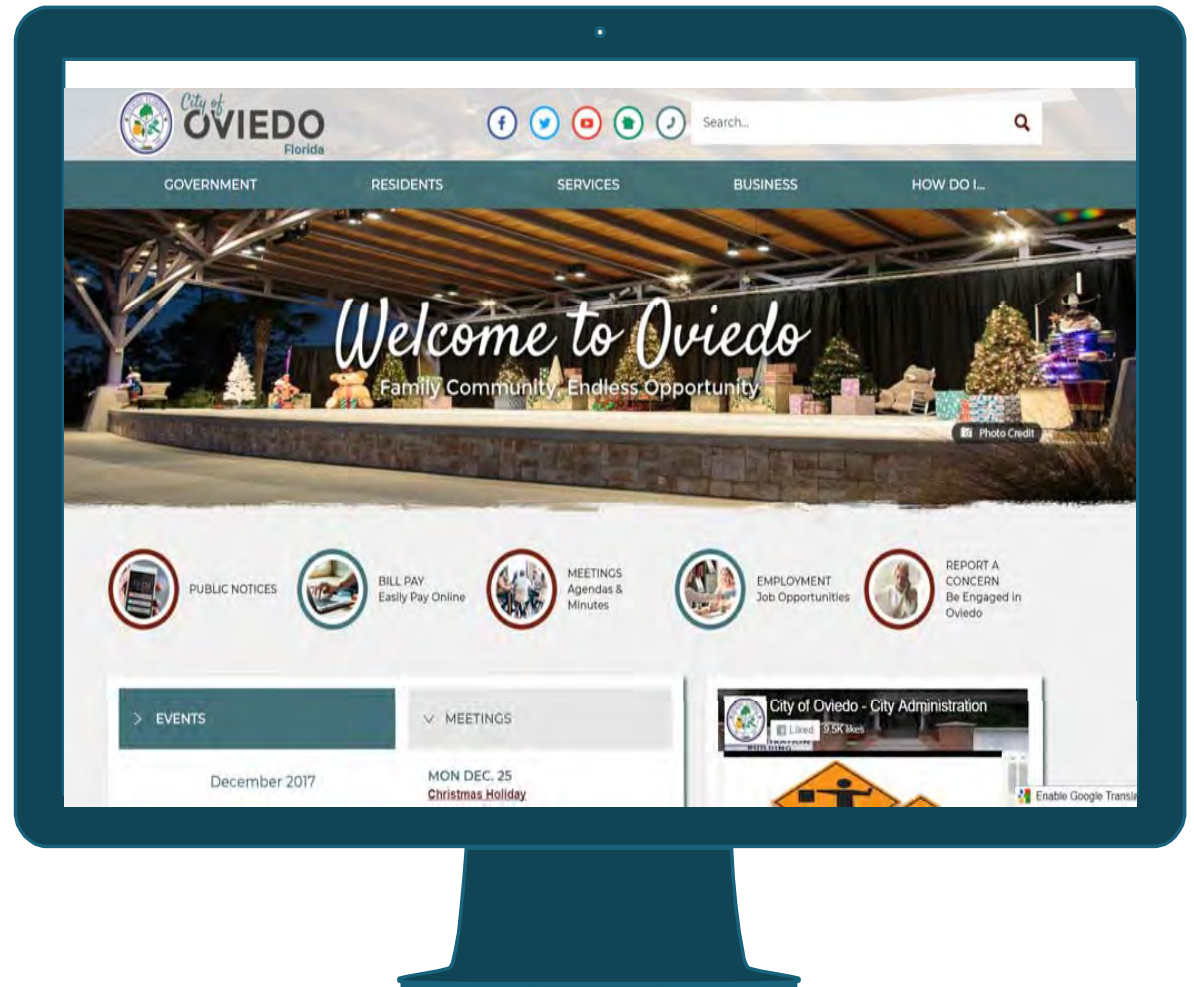

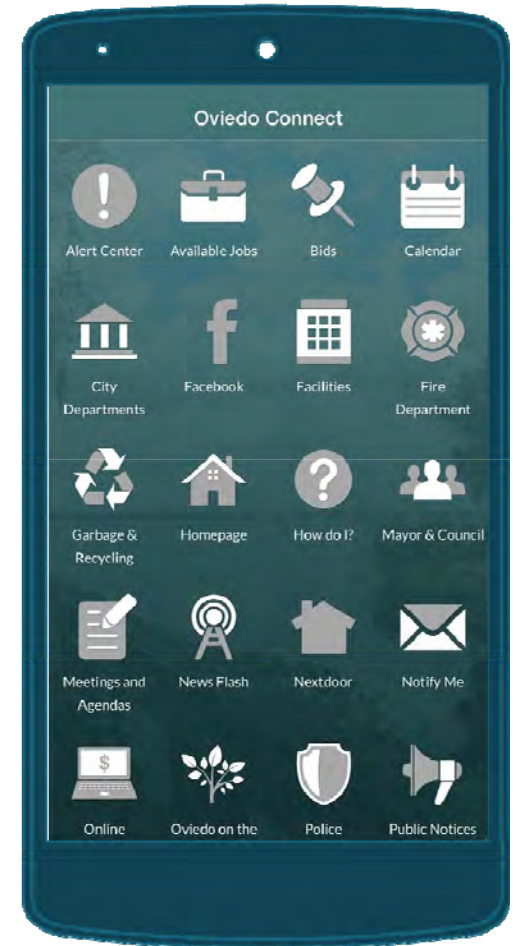

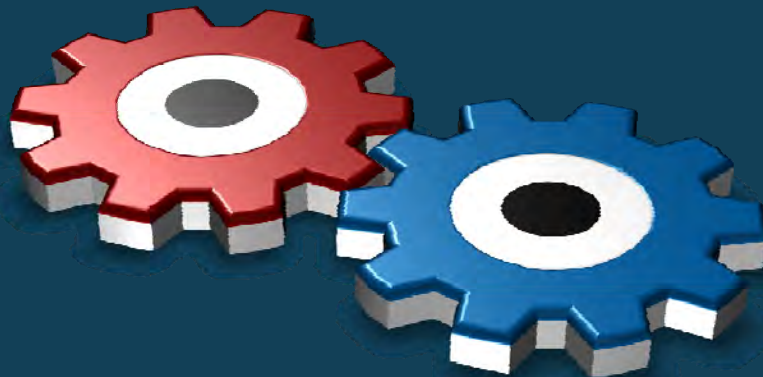
Proposed Street Lighting Assessment

- ☐ Provides a dedicated revenue source for street lighting.
- ☐ Assessment will fund the following:
 - Energy costs associated with operating the current street lighting in public rights-of-way city wide.
 - Maintenance of street lighting in public rights-of-way and replacement of older, dilapidated poles.
 - Upgrading of existing street lighting to energy-efficient Light Emitting Diode (LED) technology.
 - Expand lighting in non-lighted areas, such as Mitchell Hammock Road.
- ☐ Street lighting enhances the public safety, security, and quality of life of the City of Oviedo's residents, business owners, and patrons.

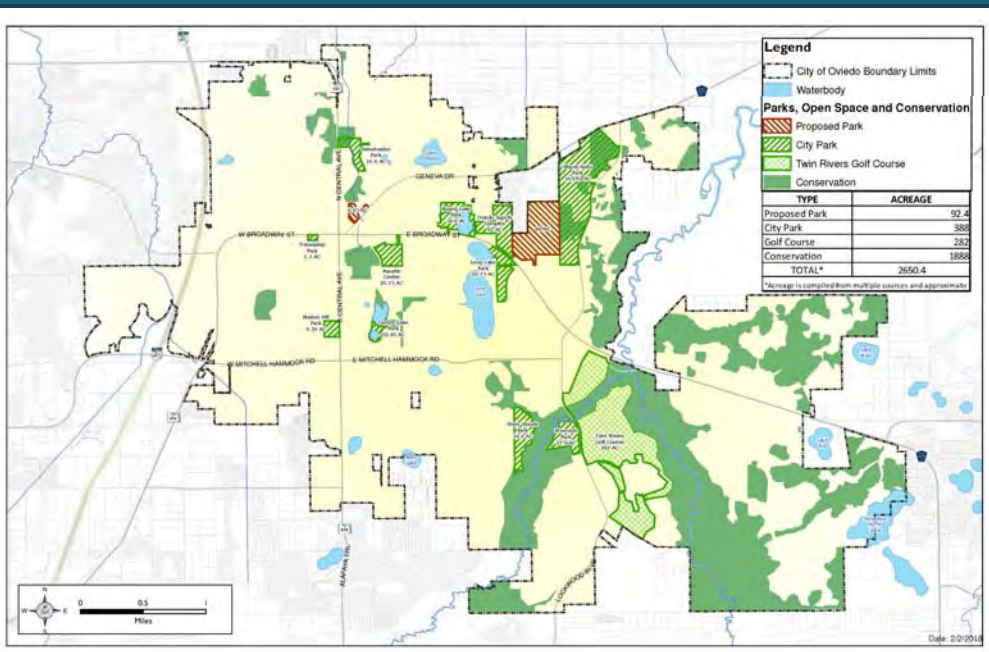

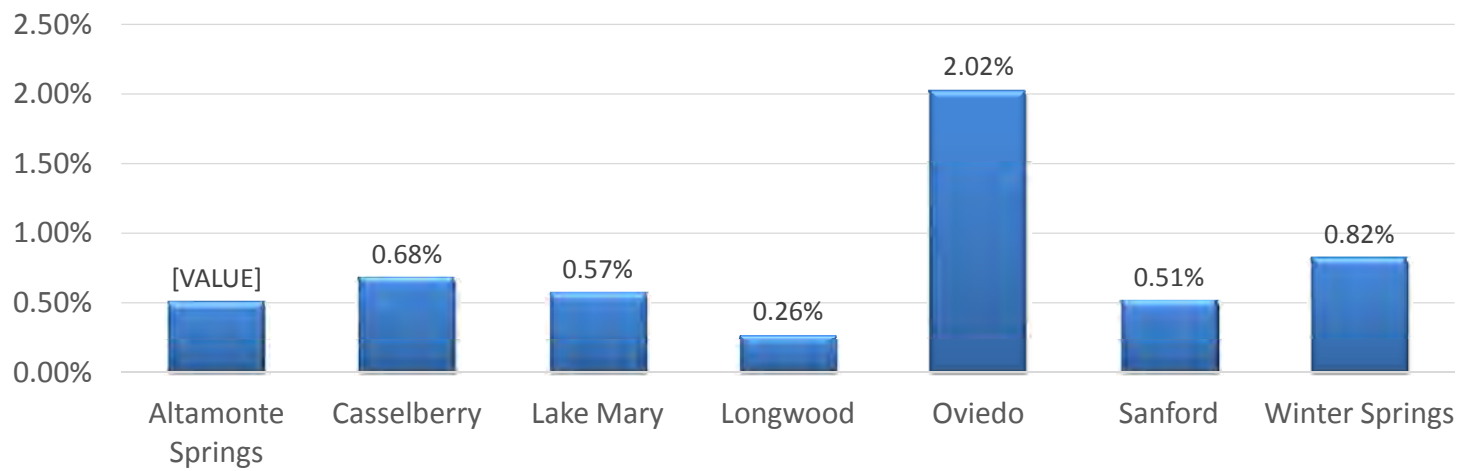

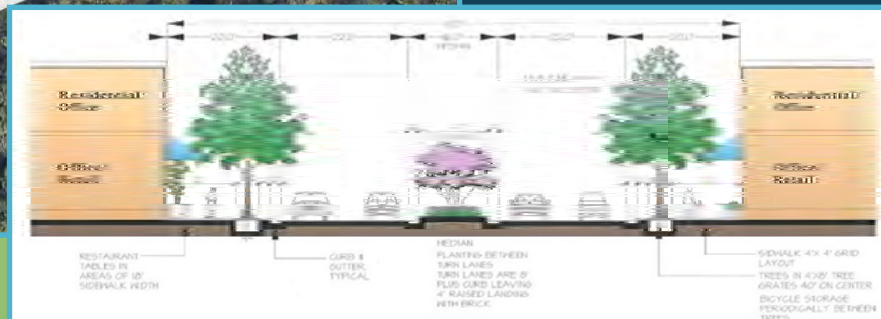


Oviedo Leads the Way!

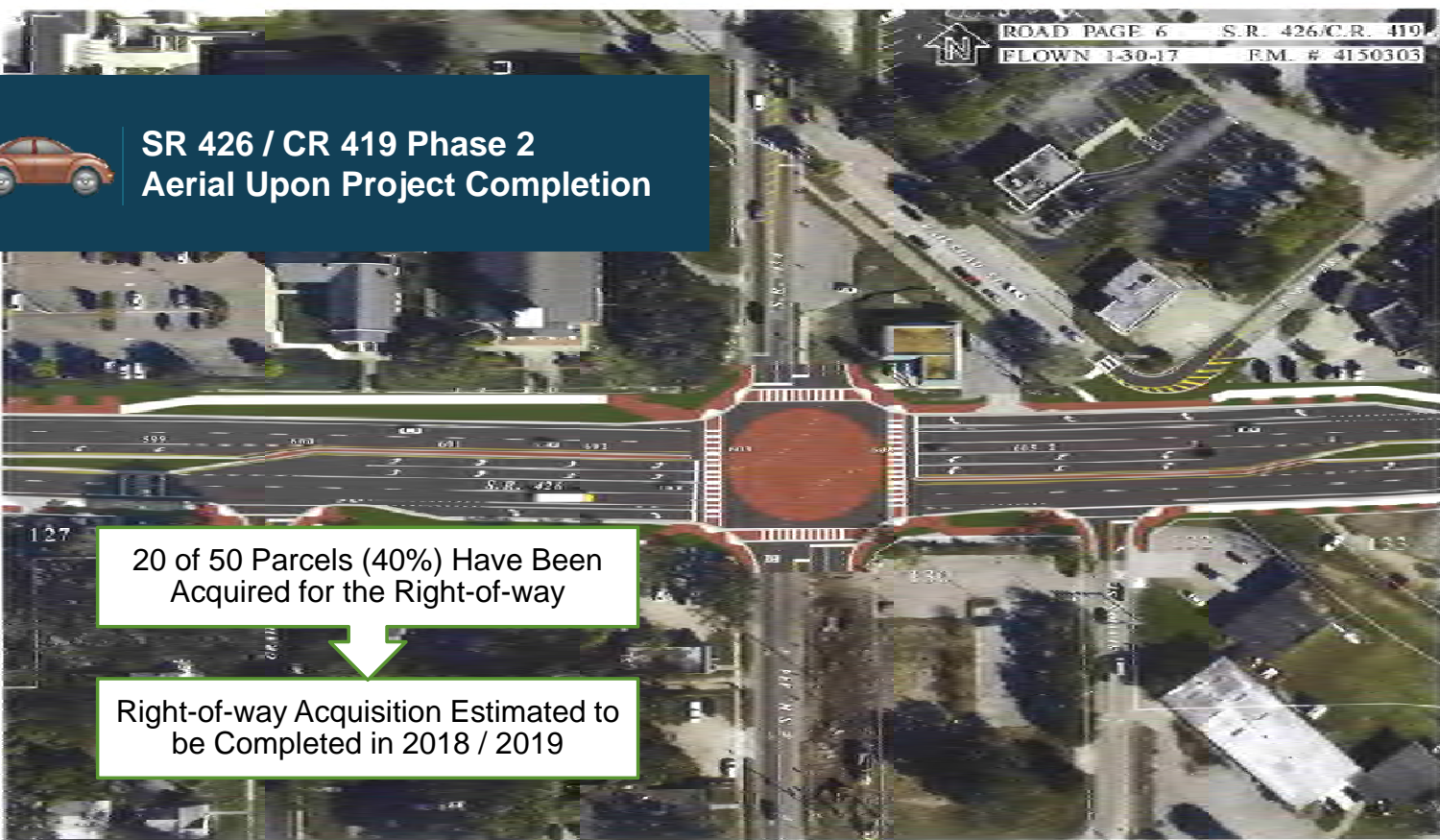

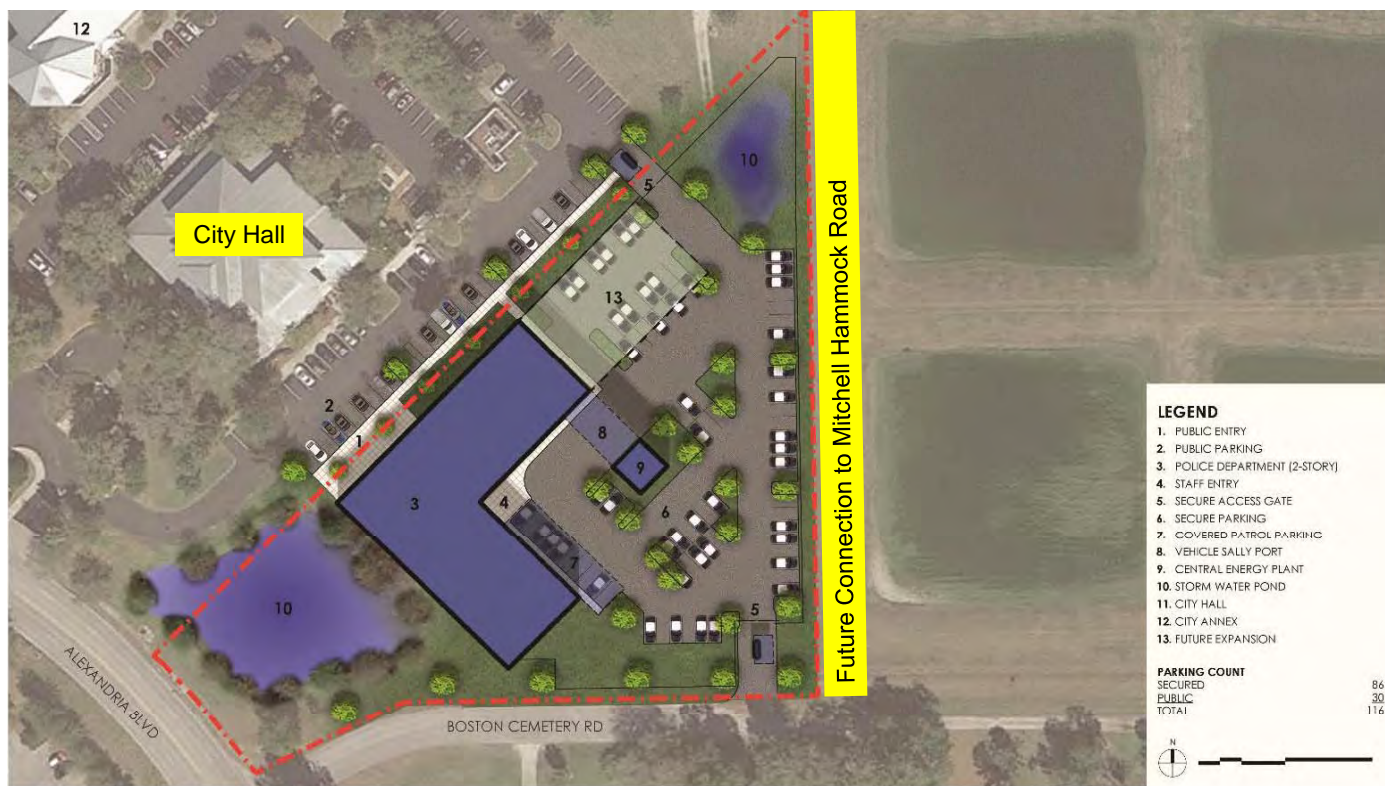
